Summary: Under the direction of the Clinical Services Manager, the Clinical Supervisor is a supervisory, full-time position under the direction of the Clinical Services Manager. The Clinical Supervisor ensures the quality of services being provided by the clinical unit through individual supervision of clinical staff, chart review, and implementation of other quality assurance measures. This position is designated as a hybrid role.

Schedule: Monday - Friday, 10:00 AM - 7:00 PM with 24/7 crisis response coverage.

Duties/ Responsibilities:

- **Supervision**
 - Provide individual and/or group supervision for clinical staff including all clinicians, case managers, and in-home counselors providing mental health, child abuse prevention, intervention & treatment, family preservation, and parenting education services.
 - Ensure delivery of appropriate mental health and other clinical services to clients including support services for client and family members
 - Review of all documentation for service provided including intake, assessments, progress notes, referral logs, and service coordination plans for accuracy and timeliness.
 - Provide on-going supervision as well as crisis intervention consultation.
 - Enhance clinical skills of staff through supervision, coordinating training opportunities including in-service training.
 - Assist with recruitment, hiring and training of new staff and coordination of new services.
 - Provide 24/7 crisis response coverage.
- **Other Services**
 - Attend all relevant agency, partner and clinical unit meetings.
 - Attend conferences, workshops, training seminars, and community forums as directed by the Clinical Services Manager.
- **Perform other related duties as assigned by the Clinical Services Unit Manager.**



Minimum Requirements / Qualifications (All applicants MUST meet the minimum qualifications):

- License in Clinical Social Work or Marriage and Family Therapy.
- 7- 10 years of clinical experience in addition to 2 years of supervision experience.
- Knowledge and/ or experience in working with underserved communities.
- Experience in working with low- income children youth and families from diverse cultural and ethnic backgrounds.
- Bilingual in **Korean/English** or **Spanish/English**.
- Have a strong sense of prioritization and can coordinate multiple demands in a high- pressure environment.
- Strong organizational, written and communication skills.
- Ability to work collaboratively with others and a willingness to participate fully in the team process.
- Proof of passing a TB test (if completed within a year).
- Proof of full COVID-19 series and Vaccination Record.
- Certification in CPR and First Aid Training.
- Proof of eligibility to work in the United States.
- A valid Class C California Driver's License, access to personal automobile, and proof of auto insurance.
- Physical requirements: Able to sit for long periods of time, able to see to inspect the field and written documents; ability to communicate with KYCC staff, affiliates, clients and public; and dexterity of hands and fingers to operate office equipment.
